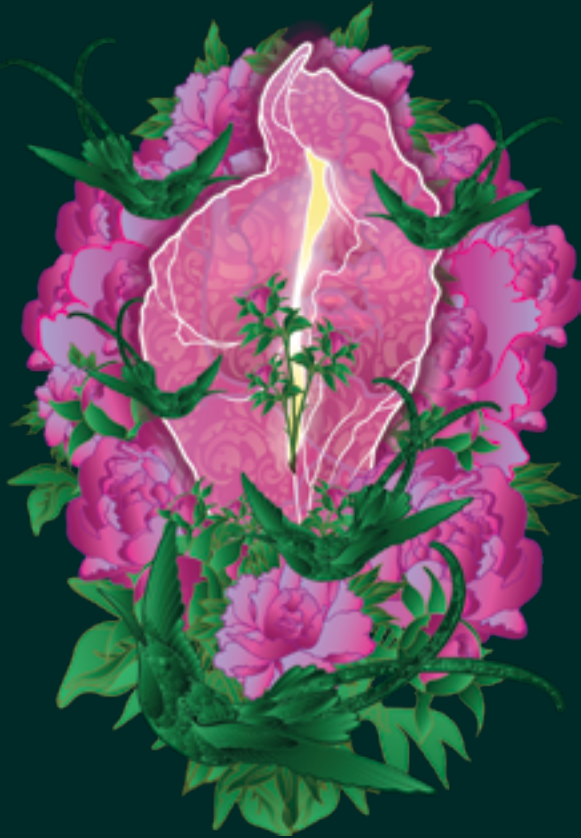

# Project YONISPHERE

*A story about rediscovering respect for one's own body,  
a project that transmits the essence of a woman.*

The Yonisphere project, created by Veronika Fodorová, is a unique artistic and therapeutic initiative that focuses on rediscovering respect, acceptance of diversity, beauty of human sexuality, and the body. This project invites us to open ourselves to new perspectives, while understanding and actively participating in the transformation process. In this context, art meets a therapeutic approach to promote emotional healing and mental health.

## **A story of forgiveness and acceptance**

The Yonisphere Project is a story of forgiveness and acceptance. Veronika Fodorová, the author of the project, used her work as a form of therapy that helped her overcome her own injuries and find self-acceptance. This personal process of healing and forgiveness is the foundation of a project that encourages women to embrace their identity and beauty. Through a series of paintings called "Yoniradiators", Veronika emphasizes the unique beauty and power of the female body and sexuality.

## **Artistic testimony and therapeutic approach**

In the Yonisphere project, artistic expression meets a therapeutic approach to healing emotional wounds. Each of the 13 paintings in this series is a unique portrait that reflect the unique beauty and strength of the female body. Based on real photographs of a woman's vagina, these

images represent the infinite variety, sacredness, and uniqueness of the gates of life. This approach not only promotes self-acceptance, but also the courageous expression of one's own identity.

## **Transformation through knowledge**

The Yonisphere project is a means of liberation and emancipation. It encourages women to accept themselves and to boldly express their identity. This project brings people together and takes part in creating a safe and supportive environment for women. It is challenging to rewire our attitudes and behaviors towards ourselves and others, and to promote mental health and self-acceptance.

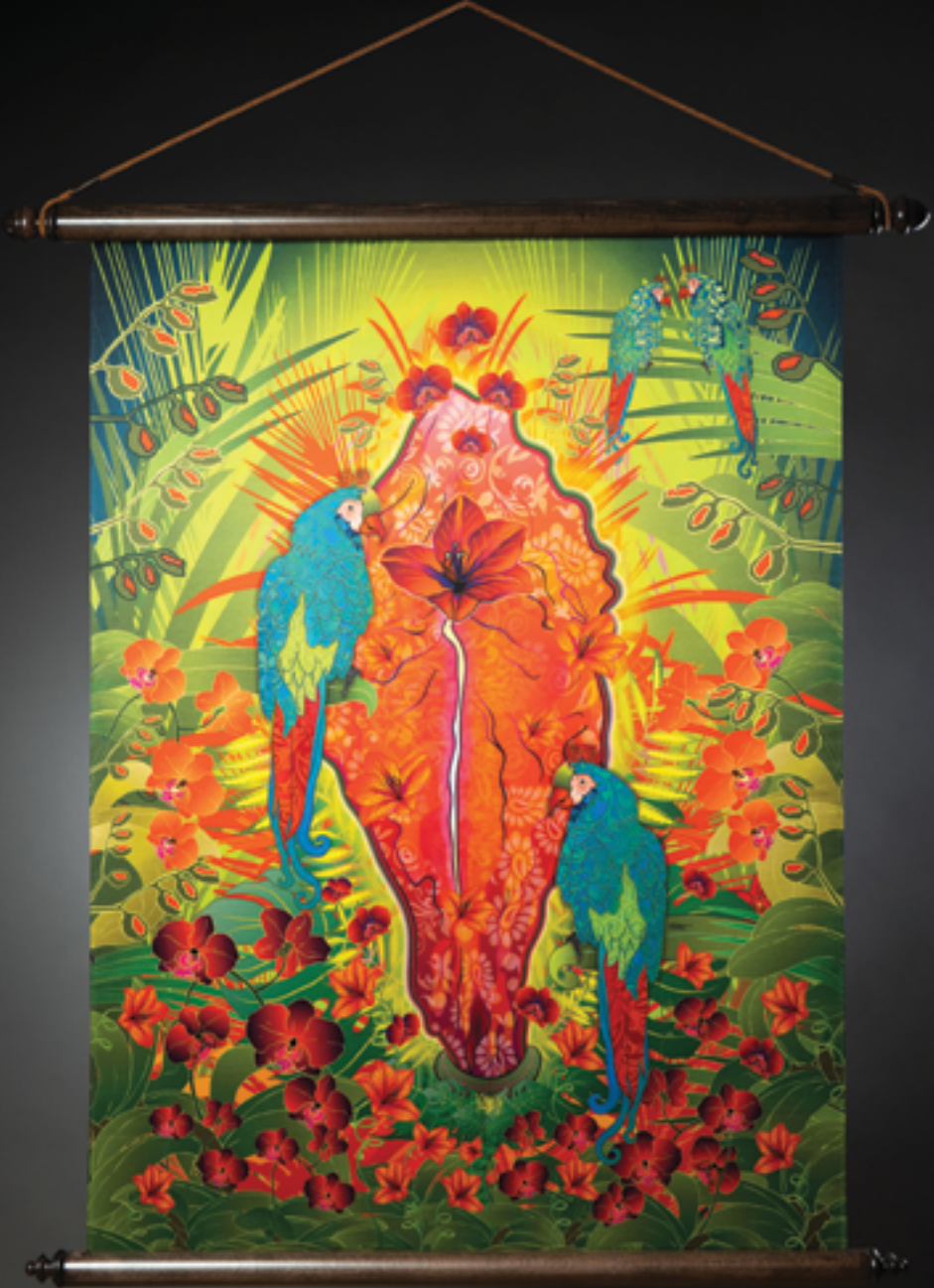
## **Silk Scroll as a Communication Output**

One of the unique aspects of the Yonisphere project is the use of silk scrolls as a communication output. Silk, as a material, has a symbolic meaning. It is firm, but also very pliable, which creates a strong parallel to womanhood as such. Ancient scrolls have been a form of communication since the beginning of time, and the Yonisphere Project continues this tradition to send messages and knowledge to the world.

## **Technical parameters**

100% pure Italian silk satin (90 x 120 cm), reinforced with two layers of vlizeline, inserted in beech rods with decorative beech end caps (length 108 cm).

Silk Satin is produced in workshops that supply famous fashion brands such as GUCCI or PRADA. The silk used is exclusively from the European Union and meets the utmost highest requirements of sustainable and ethical fashion.



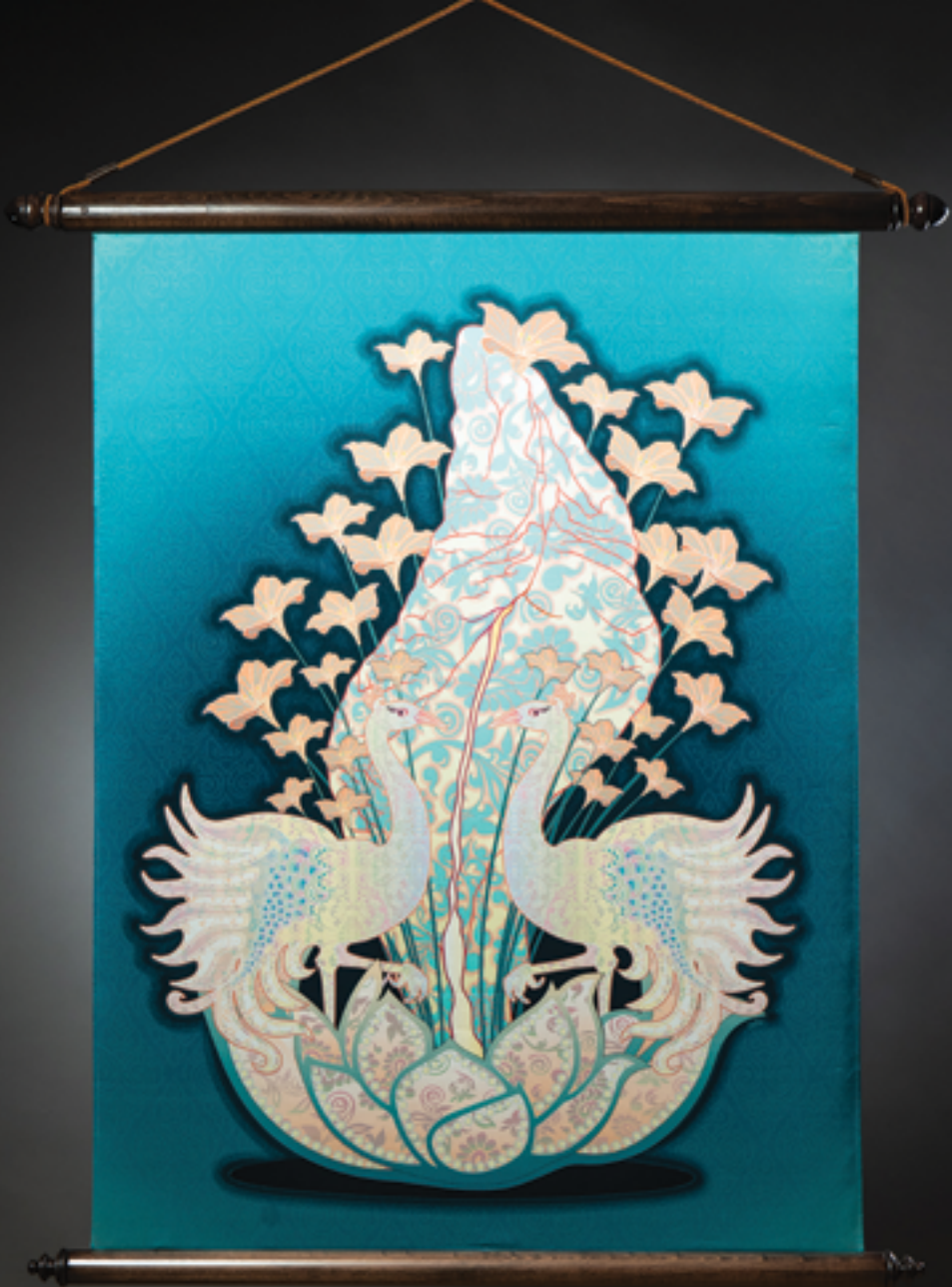

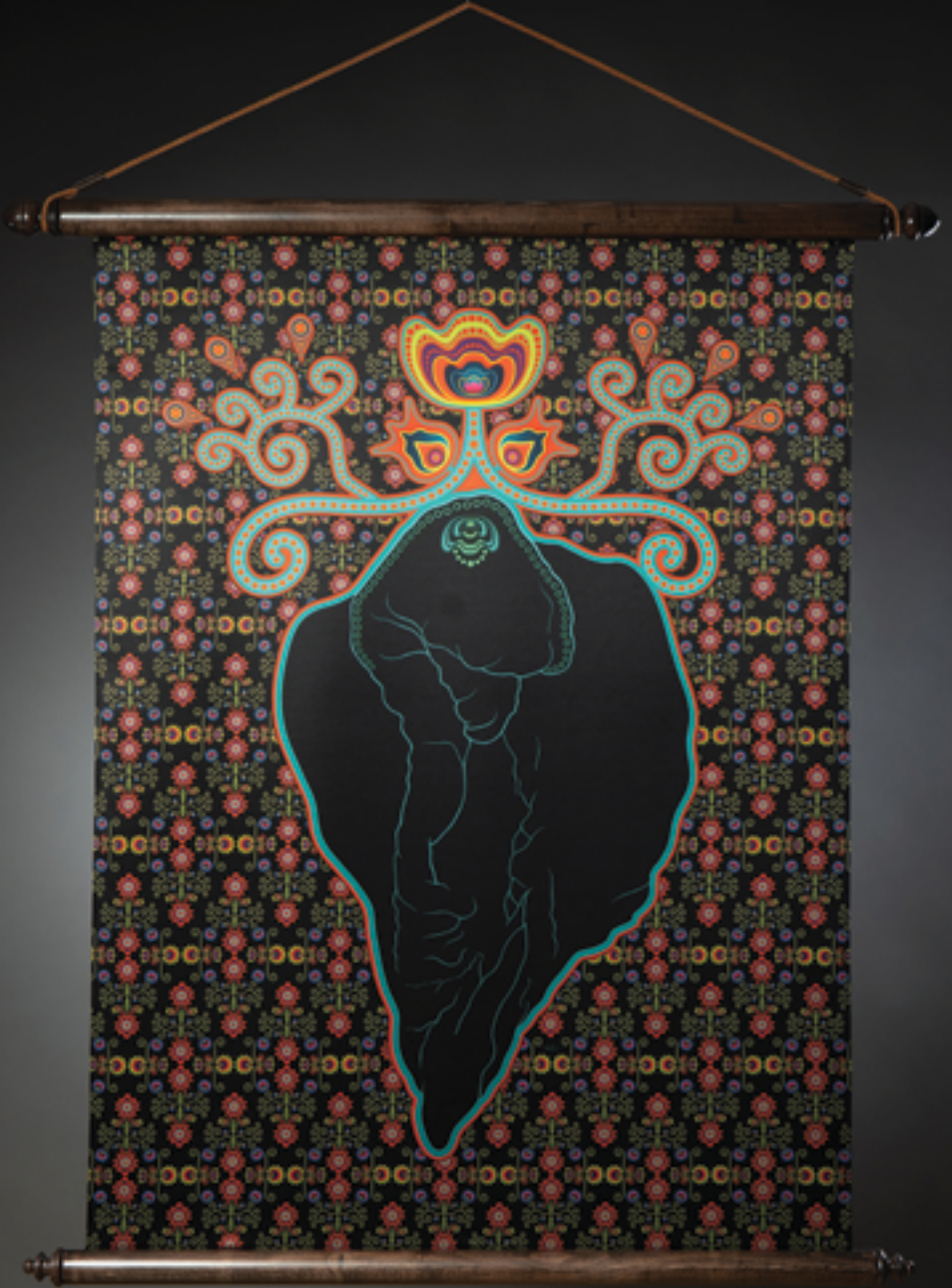

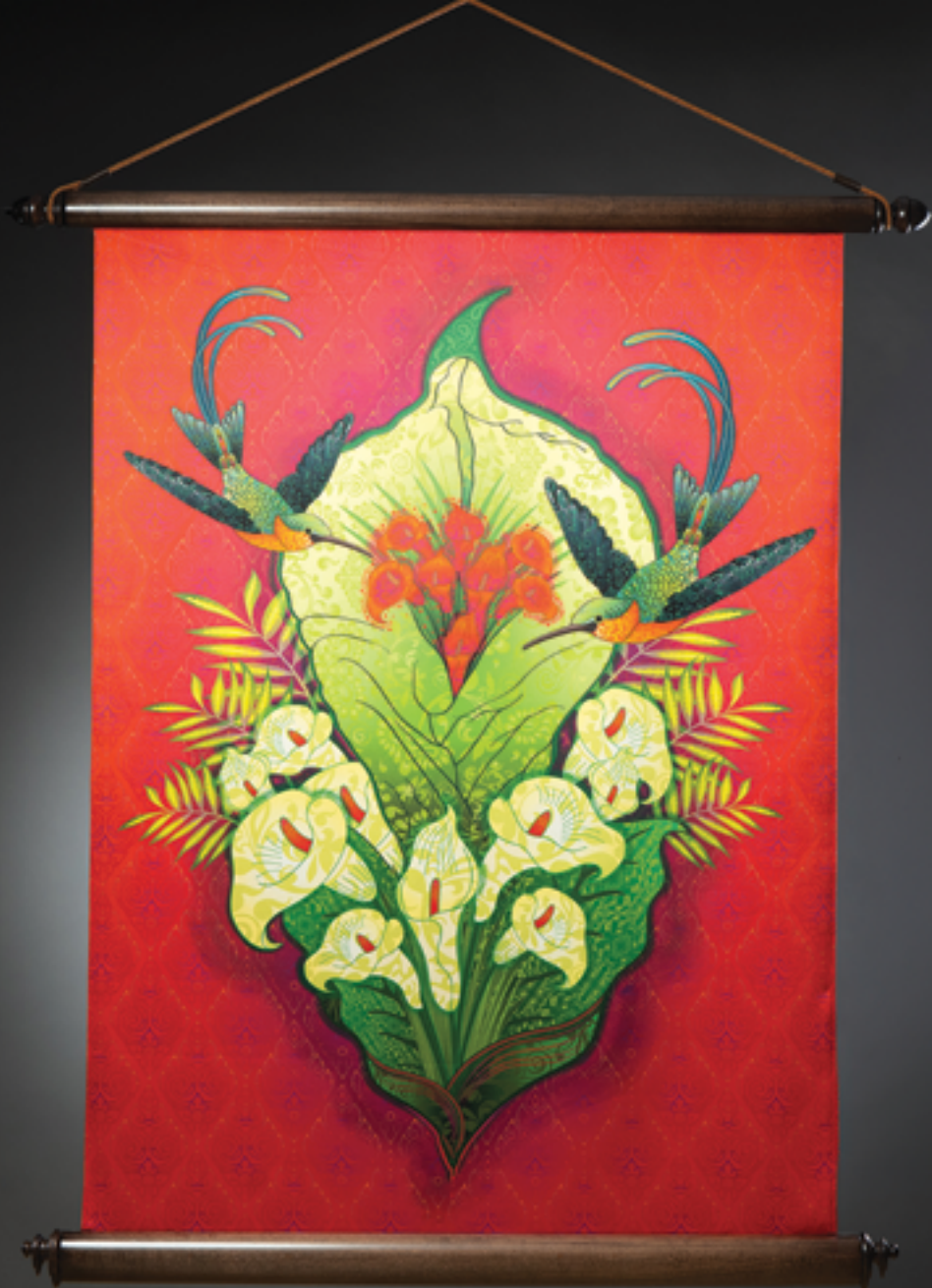

# Veronika FODOROVA



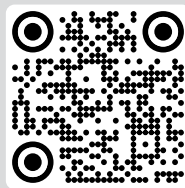
